


# Wiley E-Text with D2L

## Pairing your E-Text

Wiley E-Texts (Powered by VitalSource®) can be integrated into your course LMS for a more immersive and engaging learning experience. This will create deep links to chapter level content allowing your students to have fast and easy access to quality, relevant and tailored education content at the point of learning – with everything they need in one place.

### Step 1:

Before you can integrate please first check that the Wiley E-Text package has been imported into your course by your University D2L team. The package will contain Wiley E-Text links which will be titled “Chapter 1” etc. and will appear in your *Content* area






## Step 2:

Once this is completed there is one more step to configure these links and make them available for your students. This is by adding the consumer key and shared secret to each link. The consumer key and shared secret is unique to your university and can be requested from your Wiley Sales Representative.


To add the consumer key and shared secret select *Course Admin* and then *External Learning Tools*



Repeat the following process for each E-Text Chapter link – Select *Edit Link*




Then enter in the consumer key and shared secret, ensuring that *Link Key/Secret* is selected
